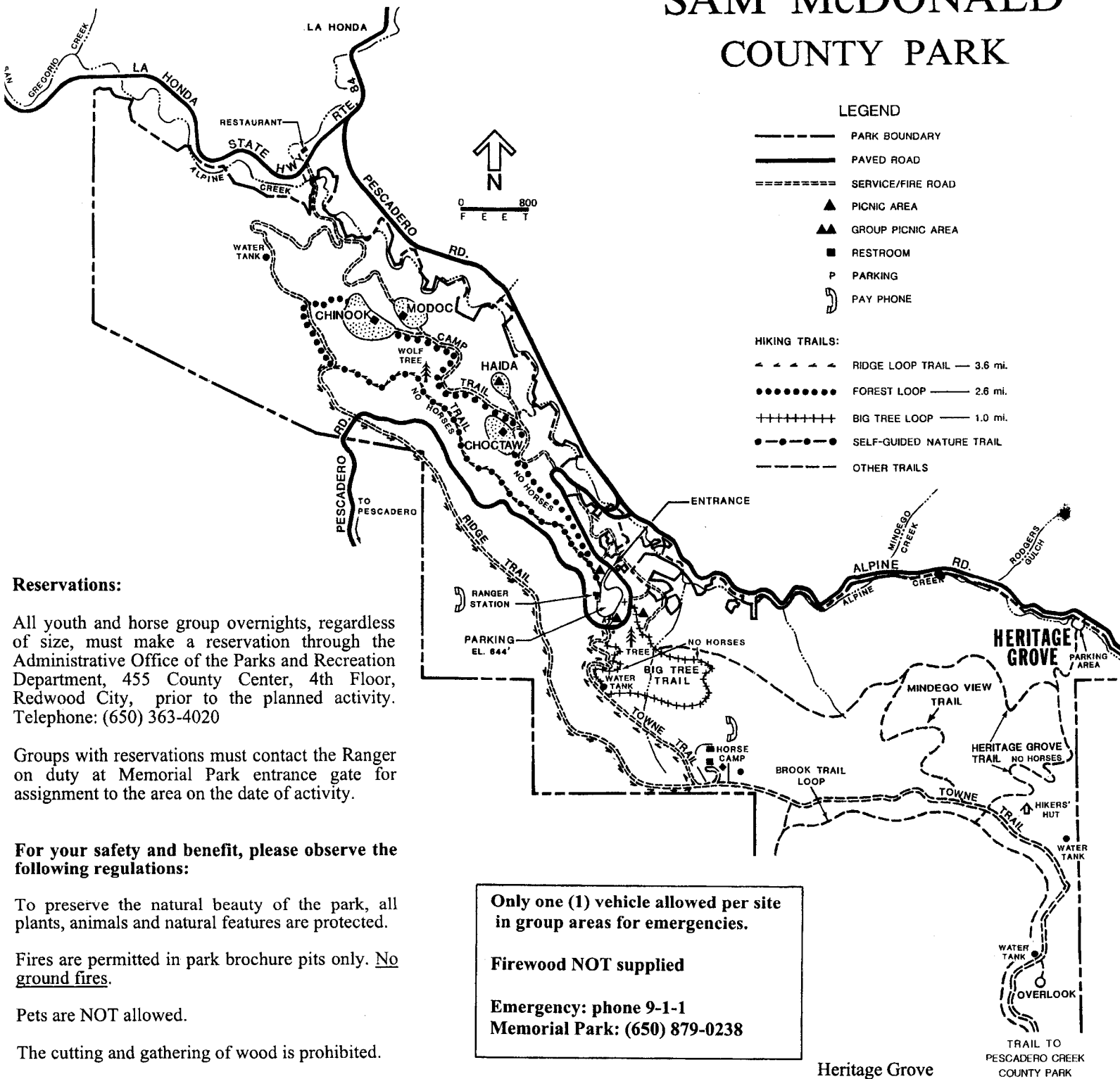


SAM McDONALD COUNTY PARK



Reservations:

All youth and horse group overnights, regardless of size, must make a reservation through the Administrative Office of the Parks and Recreation Department, 455 County Center, 4th Floor, Redwood City, prior to the planned activity. Telephone: (650) 363-4020

Groups with reservations must contact the Ranger on duty at Memorial Park entrance gate for assignment to the area on the date of activity.

For your safety and benefit, please observe the following regulations:

To preserve the natural beauty of the park, all plants, animals and natural features are protected.

Fires are permitted in park brochure pits only. No ground fires.

Pets are NOT allowed.

The cutting and gathering of wood is prohibited.

Loud radios and playing of musical instruments, amplifiers and other loud noises are not permitted.

Motor vehicles are permitted only on designated roadways and in established parking areas.

Horses are permitted on designated trails.

Adult supervision is required for all persons under 18 years of age who are camping in the park.

Firearms and other weapons are prohibited.

Only one (1) vehicle allowed per site in group areas for emergencies.

Heritage Grove

The Heritage Grove, 37-acre preserve of magnificent old-growth redwoods adjoins the park to the northeast. Many of the grove's huge redwoods were scheduled to be logged until a citizen's group banded together to raise funds to purchase the grove so that the magnificent trees could be preserved forever. The county matched these funds and made acquisition possible. The grove can be reached by traveling east on Alpine Road, one mile west of Pescadero Road
